

# What is LOGOS?

LOGOS combines energetic fun, creativity, sharing and a focus on faithful living every Thursday for ALL God's people. It is tried and true – used in churches around the world. At Wildwood Presbyterian Church it is a time for children, teens and adults to join together, learning about the Christian faith. Dozens of volunteers give their time, lead play, teach, create, cook, nurture and care for those who come to LOGOS. In LOGOS, we celebrate positive relationships through the model of Jesus Christ.

## What does the word LOGOS mean?

*"In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God." John 1:1.*

In the original Greek, Logos is used for "Word," and in Christian understanding, **Christ is the Logos.**

## FUN

**Recreation:** One of the key elements of LOGOS is FUN. Our safe, noncompetitive lively fun choices for activities in 2011 2012 include: arts & crafts, cooperative games, outdoor play, science experiments and more!

Dinner is served at **Family Time!** Each week we share a family-style meal. God's people of all ages share conversation and table activities together. song! Meals are tied to fun themes and always include fruit and veggies!

**Worship Skills** are taught to and caught by all while having fun learning the importance of worshipping God with thanks and praise. We encourage everyone to get involved in worship and to share their love for music, art, and dance, among other gifts, with the congregation during Sunday morning worship.
